RAISE THE ROOF!

CAMPAIGN LAUNCHED TO RAISE £5000 FOR

GRUNDISBURGH PAVILION

A campaign has been launched to raise cash for re-roofing Grundisburgh's pavilion - essential if organisations such as the Playgroup are to survive.

The Pavilion Committee wants to replace the existing flat roof, which is costly to maintain, with a pitched one needing little maintenance.

Then, rents for use of the pavilion will no longer need to include a high maintenance charge, removing a heavy financial burden from the playgroup, football, tennis and other clubs.

And the committee aims eventually to provide further sports and social facilities at the pavilion, to the benefit of the whole village. Sports such as badminton and

But first £5,000 has to be raised for the new roof. So the "Raise the Roof" campaign will get off to a big start with a 12-mile sponsored walk, The Grundisburgh Marathon. This is an event for all the family, and will be along footpaths and lanes around Grundisburgh on Sunday May 31st, starting between 9 and 10a.m. Refreshments will be provided and there will be pick-up points for early finishers.
